The Chairperson, Ms. Vrinda Sarup welcomed the members of the Managing Committee of DPS Dibrugarh to the first Management Committee meeting of the school.

2. To apprise the members of the present status of the school on the following:

- (i) Infrastructure of the school- The building is ready with 36 classrooms and all other facilities. The sport fields are in the process of getting completed.
- (ii) Strength of the school in 2019-2020- 133
- (iii) No. of academic & non-academic staff. - Total Staff-20, Regularized-10, Contractual-5 and PartTime-5.
- (iv) Requirement of staff for session 2020-2021- 5
- (v) To apprise the members about the admission process- Admission only by interaction with parents from classes KG-1 and by interaction with parents and students from classes 2-7. Inclusive education policy adopted.

3. To approve the fee structure and budget of the school for the year 2019-2020 & 2020-2021.-

The fee structure in both the last and current sessions is the same.
The budget for 2020-2021 was explained by PVC, DPS Dibrugarh.
Sh. Kaushik Datta, Member, wanted to know with how many students the school will reach a breakeven point. To this the PVC replied, as 700 students.

5. To approve the opening of the Bank account.

A separate bank account in the name of Delhi Public School, Dibrugarh has been opened with State Bank of India, Dibrugarh with Account No. is-37965436707. The Committee noted the action taken.

6. To approve the appointment of auditors-

The Committee noted that DPS Dibrugarh has appointed CA. ~~Sijma~~ Kejriwal Singhania as auditor for the school. The Chairperson emphasized that the audited accounts of the school must be placed before the MC latest by every September at the latest.

7. To approve the appointments / resignation of staff-

All appointments were approved by the Management Committee based on the due selection process.

8. To note the academic activity and progress of the school since the beginning-

The Principal, Mrs. Probhati Biswas, presented the journey of the school since the beginning with special emphasis on the achievements, staff development programmes and their participation in training programmes conducted by DPS, HRD.

9. To note the participation in DPS HRD programmes-

All DPS teachers, including the Principal have participated in all the training programmes conducted by DPS, HRD.

10. To note the status of CBSE Affiliation-

All procedures required to be fulfilled by the school for CBSE affiliation have been completed. An inspection team has been constituted by CBSE which will inspect the school when it reopens after the Covid-19 period.
